CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

The Casterton Kelpie Festival consists of the following events **which need registration** – the Kelpie Hill Climb, Kelpie Dash and Kelpie High Jump.

Plus, the Kelpie Triathlon which is a test of endurance, speed and stamina by a Kelpie across all 3 of the above events.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY – for ALL events are as follows:

- All entrants **MUST** register at www.trybooking.com and follow the links.
- Due to COVID restriction only 1 kelpie per entrant are permitted.
- On the day each Kelpie must be vetted by our Officials prior to attending the Registration Desk, where you will receive an ID number - please refer to our website for the ***Definition of a Kelpie***.
- The Registration Desk is open between 8am and 10am on the Town Hall steps.
- Registrations **close at 10am sharp**, no late entries will be considered.
- All successful entrants will be given a CKA lanyard and ID Number and tag– the committee wishes you to ***keep these items as a memento*** from the Casterton Kelpie Festival 2021.
- Kelpie Triathlon – entrants will be issued with a blue identification bib which **must be returned** after the event.
- **Official presentation for the Kelpie Triathlon** will be made at the end of the Kelpie Hill Climb on location at approximately 4.30pm, all other event presentations will take place at the end of each event.

We invite all Entrants to take part of the annual **Kelpie Street Parade** commencing at 10am from the Australian Kelpie Centre, please ensure you assemble at 9.45am.
